What does Greg Lopez believe?

Sanctity of Life:

I believe that only God has the right to take a life, whether in the womb, beginning at conception, or before natural death. I am pro-life, without exceptions.

Traditional Marriage:

I believe in the biblical view of marriage, that it is the union of one man and one woman.

2nd Amendment:

Our Founders embedded in the Constitution the right to bear arms. The primary reason was to protect the private citizen from a potential threat from the government that they had just created. Nothing has changed. That right remains and must be protected at all costs.

Immigration:

The original documents that created America’s immigration policy stated that any whom we would consider to become citizens would bring ‘added value’ to our country and pledge their allegiance to it. That is still what we should embrace as our legal immigration standard today and our immigration laws should reflect that.

Sanctuary Cities:

The 'Rule of Law' is the foundation of all that we hold near and dear in America. I am opposed to sanctuary city/state policies and will do everything in my power as governor to end them in Colorado.

Colorado Taxes and TABOR:

The voters clearly expressed their mistrust of the state government's tax/spend practices by passing the TABOR amendment (Tax Payer Bill or Rights). I strongly support TABOR and know that we can do everything a state government should do within the TABOR taxing formula. I will also explore tax reform options.

Education:

We clearly need a new direction as it relates to the education of our children. When only 30% of our 8th graders are proficient in math & science there is a problem. I will do a full financial review and make sure that funds provided for education are being spent effectively for the education of students, and spend only what is necessary for administration. I will work with small business to provide vocational training in high school so that graduates are ready to go to work if they choose not to go to college.

PERA:

I am committed to doing what is necessary to meet all unfunded liabilities in the program and ensure commitments to our state employees are fully met. I will also re-organize the PERA (Public Employee Retirement Association) board, bringing in outside board members who are not dependent on PERA. I want to avoid situations where board members are conflicted by votes they cast before sending recommendations to the statehouse for approval.

Water:

Water resources are critical for the future of Colorado. As Governor, I pledge to conduct a thorough review of the Colorado Water Plan generated by the Colorado Water Conservation Board – and work very closely with them and the Colorado Water Congress to ensure the needs of all Colorado citizens and various industries are protected now and in the future.

Transportation:

Maintaining and improving the roads in our great state is vitally important to our economy.

In the near term, we must adequately maintain our existing roads and I will continue to fast-track the I-25 corridor improvements without establishing toll lanes. In addition I will ensure we have plans well into the future to support our transportation needs as our population and economy grows.

Military:

As governor, I will be in total sync with Gen. Loh, the Adjutant General of the Colorado National Guard. The thousands of Colorado Guard men and women deserve the best equipment and mission capabilities we can draw to our state in order to support their mission. I will utilize our National Guard troops to support our state and our homeland as the need arises. I will work with the Department of Homeland Security to offer assistance when the expertise of our Guard is needed.
